1. Fairness & Bias

Audit your AI — bias hides in data, not intent.

Check:

- ☐ **Data sources are diverse and balanced.**
- ☐ **Outputs are tested for bias by multiple reviewers.**
- ☐ **Feedback is captured from diverse users.**
- ☐ **Decisions made by AI are explainable.**

Quick Tip:

If you can't explain it, you can't defend it.

2. Transparency & Accountability

AI shouldn't be a black box.

People should understand how and why it reaches conclusions.

Check:

- ☐ **AI decision criteria are documented.**
- ☐ **There's a clear owner for every AI system.**
- ☐ **Users can challenge and correct outcomes.**
- ☐ **Ethics reviews are scheduled annually.**

Quick Tip:

Transparency is the foundation of trust.

3. Continuous Improvement

AI evolves — so must your oversight.

Check:

- ☐ Model performance is reviewed quarterly.
- ☐ Data drift alerts are monitored.
- ☐ Ethical breaches are logged and resolved.
- ☐ Learnings are shared to refine governance.

Quick Tip:

Ethics isn't a policy — it's a practice.
